Paper Submission Guidelines

- **Required paper format:** Maximum of 10 pages (including abstract, tables, figures, and references), 1-inch margins, 11-point font or higher, single column, single-spaced, and 50-word abstract. Note that any content after the 10th page will be removed.
- Papers must be submitted via this <u>link</u>. Submissions must be submitted on time to be considered for review.
- Submitted papers should be neither published nor accepted for publication elsewhere at the time of submission.
- Participation is exclusive to members of the INFORMS Data Mining Society. Previous finalists of the DMDA Workshop Best Paper Competition must submit new work to be considered for the competition.
- Papers selected as a finalist in either competition track may not simultaneously serve as finalists in other competitions at the 2025 INFORMS Annual Meeting (including those organized within DMS). If such a conflict arises, please inform the competition co-chairs (contact information is provided at the end of this document).
- Finalists in either track will be recommended for **fast-track submission** to the <u>INFORMS Journal on Data Science (IJDS</u>). Details will be provided to the finalists.
- **Copyright:** The DMDA workshop will **not** retain the copyright of submitted papers; therefore, the authors are free to submit their papers to other outlets. Please keep in mind, however, that fast-track submission to IJDS will be made available to finalists.
